



Local Charity Celebrates Breast Cancer Awareness

Unique Flower Installation at Historic Crescent Bend Home

KNOXVILLE, TN – Volunteers, board members and the staff Random Acts of Flowers will join the team at Crescent Bend House and Gardens **Saturday, December 10** to plant a special installation of “pink-ribbon” bulbs in honor of breast cancer awareness. Together more than 4,500 pink tulips and hyacinths will be planted in the shape of a large pink ribbon on a hillside in the lower gardens overlooking the Tennessee River.

The bulbs will bloom just in time for Crescent Bend’s “Blooms for the Cure” springtime event on **Sunday, April 1**. Thirty thousand tulips of various shades of pink will serve as the backdrop for this day-long event that raises funds for the Knoxville Affiliate of Susan G. Komen for the Cure.

This unique installation by Random Acts of Flowers is made possible through the support of Care Institute Group, Inc., a nonprofit charitable corporation.
