In 2020, Random Acts of Flowers faced many of the same challenges that most organizations and nonprofits faced due to the pandemic. We closed for seven weeks due to the pandemic, and when we re-opened, we adhered to all Knox County Health Departments guidelines. Despite these challenges, Random Acts of Flowers was able to deliver more than 12,000 bouquets of repurposed flowers to individuals in healthcare facilities here in the Greater Knoxville area. In addition, we repurposed over 20,000 vases and recycled over 10 tons of green waste. Not only do we deliver smiles and moments of kindness to individuals in healthcare facilities, we also focus on being good stewards of the environment by leaving a minimal environmental footprint. With a staff of only three full-time employees, the only way Random Acts of Flowers can create and deliver this many personal moments of kindness is due to the support of our dedicated, fun-loving, and hard-working volunteers, and our generous, committed donors.

- Made our 500,000th delivery arrangement to the University of Tennessee Medical Center
- Relocated to a new workshop (2936 Middlebrook Pike, Knoxville, TN 37921) that has great visibility and
  is centrally located for our floral donors, our floral deliveries, and for our volunteers
- Participated in volunteer fairs and presented Random Acts of Flowers to garden clubs, service organizations, and local businesses
- Hosted groups of intellectual and developmentally disabled individuals and provided them with socialization activities that contribute to our mission
