RAF Celebrates Additional National Mission Expansion

September 2014 marked another great milestone as RAF kicked-off expansion efforts in Chicago, IL. After a successful fundraising effort, the new branch facility was opened (located in Evanston, IL) and the team started setting up the branch in November – all in anticipation of the official launch of **RAF Chicago** in late January 2015. We're excited to bring the RAF mission to the Midwest and help serve the Chicagoland healthcare community!



In early November, RAF's newest expansion effort began in California with a kick-off celebration in Menlo Park to help establish **RAF Silicon Valley**. The leadership team is working hard to complete fundraising efforts, secure a facility location, hire the team, build the local board of directors and begin recruiting volunteers. We expect to open the facility in February and begin serving Bay Area healthcare facilities in early April 2015.



Development is already underway to bring Random Acts of Flowers to Indianapolis, IN, Salt Lake City, UT and Nashville, TN in the coming years.
